Role Description for IFJSC Coaches

- Be a role model to all junior players
- All Coaches with the E&DJSA are required to hold a current working with children police clearance.
- Abide by all guidelines outlined in accordance with the E&DJSA Constitution elizdists.com.au/constitution
- Be responsible and set guidelines with their players.
- Attend Coaches meetings.
- Be responsible for equipment given at the start of season and hand back any faulty equipment.
- Hand back all IFJSC equipment at completion of season and final training session.
- Ensure that when not in use the equipment room and clubroom are secure. Lock all doors and turn off pitch lights if last member to vacate premises.
- Relinquish IFJSC keys and any IFJSC property at completion of season.
- Encourage to help with putting up/removal of nets on game day.
- Work co-operatively with all Coaches as an example to players.
- You will be provided with all players medical forms. Please be aware of players' individual medical needs.
